1. M/s GREENSENSE WASTE RECYCLING MANAGEMENT PRIVATE LIMITED is hereby granted Authorization as a collection cum dismantling/recycling facility for collection, storage and dismantling of e-waste at the premises situated at Khasra No. 03, Near Gulshan factory, Village Nairana, Nairana, Muzaffarnagar, Uttar Pradesh, MUZAFFARNAGAR, 251203, MUZAFFARNAGAR
2. The Authorisation is granted for collection, storage and Dismantling/Recycling of Dismantling, Segregation, Refurbishing and Recycling of all type of E- Waste 900 MT/Month.
3. The authorisation shall be valid for a period from 18/07/2024 to 17/07/2029.
4. The Authorisation is granted for collection of e-Waste in compliance of the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016 as amended from any source situated within the country. The authorisation shall not be treated exclusive right alone of the industry to collect e-Waste from above locations.
5. The authorisation is granted for collection, storage and dismantling/recycling of e-Waste as prescribed under schedule-I of e-Waste rules 2016.
6. The authorisation is subject to the conditions stipulated at Annexure-A and such conditions as may be specified in the rules for the time being in force under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

Terms and conditions of authorisation

1. The e-waste collection centre shall comply with the provisions of the Environment(Protection) Act, 1986, and E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016.
2. The application of this E-waste centre is processed on the basis of recommendation submitted by the concerned Regional Office of UPPCB and the information furnished by the applicant.
3. This authorization shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorized by the Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board while storage, transport and dismantling of e-waste.
4. The person/ collection centre authorized shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the ewastes without obtaining prior permission of the Board.
5. Any unauthorized change in personnel, equipment, working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorized shall constitute a breach of this authorization.
6. It is the duty of the authorized person to take prior permission of the Board to close down the operations or activities of this E-waste collection, storage, dismantling and recycling unit.
7. An application for the renewal of this authorization shall be made, as laid down in sub-rule (VI) of rule 13(3), i.e. 120 days before the expiry of this authorization.
8. The collection centre shall provide / publish details such as address, telephone number/helpline number, e-mail, etc. of the collection centre to the general public.
9. The collection centre shall ensure that the E-waste collected by them is stored in a secured manner in the authorised premises till it is dismantled as per the guideline of CPCB in this regards.
10. The applicant shall take all necessary steps to avoid inconvenience to the neighbours.
11. The collection centre cum dismantling shall ensure that the collected waste is not stored for more than 180 days. The collection centre shall not collect any waste other than E-waste as mentioned at Schedule-I.
12. The collection cum dismantling centre shall ensure that no damage is being caused to the environment during storage and dismantling of E-waste.
13. The collection centre cum dismantling shall preferably segregate E-waste into categories of IT & TE and Consumer electrical and electronics and shall store it in suitable racks / containers / bins. Height of the containers should be limited to 7 feet. Containers of appropriate size and shape shall be used for segregation of e-waste items to facilitate effective handling operations.
14. The working shed area shall be covered and must have impervious flooring.
15. The centre shall provide adequate facilities for handling / arresting leakages of compressor oils, CFCs / HCFCs in case of collection, storage and dismantling of goods like refrigerators and air conditioners etc.

16. The collection centre shall take care for proper packing of broken E-waste equipment during the storage, transportation and dismantling.
17. The collection, processing unit shall be secured with boundary wall and security personnel.
18. The proponent shall follow Rule No. 19 of E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016 for transportation of E-waste.
19. The collection centre and processing unit shall maintain records of the E-waste handled in Form - 2 and make such records available for scrutiny by the Board Officials.
20. The collection centre shall file annual returns in Form - 3 to the Board on or Before the 30th day of June following the financial year to which that return relates.
21. This authorisation is issued subject to obtaining required permissions from local authority / Fire safety Department and other relevant government departments, which are statutory requirement for carrying out the above activity.
22. The proponent shall comply with all the the directions issued by the Board from time to time.
23. Concealing the factual data, submission of false information/ fabricated data and failure to comply with any of the conditions mentioned in this authorization may result in withdrawal of this authorization and attract action under the provisions of relevant Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 as amended.
24. The Board reserves its right to modify above conditions or stipulate any further conditions in the interest of protection of the environment.
25. The Board is empowered to suspend or cancel the authorization in case of non compliance of conditions of the authorisation or with any provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 or E- waste Rules as amended.

Specific Condition:

- (1) Unit shall register on the portal.
- (2) Unit shall ensure that the facility and recycling processes are in accordance with the standards or guidelines laid down by the Central Pollution Control Board in this regard from time to time.
- (3) Unit shall ensure that the fractions or material not recycled in its facility is sent to the respective registered recyclers.
- (4) Unit shall ensure that residue generated during recycling process is disposed of in anauthorised treatment storage disposal facility.
- (5) Unit shall maintain record of e-waste collected, dismantled, recycled and sent to registered recycler on the portal and make available all records for verification or audit as and when required.
- (6) Unit shall file annual and quarterly returns in the laid down form on the portal on or before the end of the month succeeding the quarter or year, as the case may be, to which the return relates.
- (7) Unit shall accept waste electrical and electronic equipment or components not listed in Schedule-I for recycling provided that they do not contain any radioactive material and same shall be uploaded on the portal.

- (8) Unit shall create awareness through media, publications, advertisements, posters or by such other means of communication.
- (9) Unit shall account for and upload information about any non-recyclable e-waste or any quantity which is not recycled and disposed of.
- (10) Unit shall take help of dismantlers for recycling purposes: Provided that it shall be the responsibility of recycler to ensure proper material flow to and from those dismantlers and the dismantler shall give dismantled material to registered recycler only and maintain record of the same.
- (11) Every manufacturer, producer, refurbisher and recycler may store the e-waste for a period not exceeding one hundred and eighty days and shall maintain a record of sale, transfer and storage of e-wastes and make these records available for inspection and the storage of the e-waste shall be done as per the applicable rules or guidelines for the time being in force.
- (12) Recycler of solar photo-voltaic modules or panels or cells shall be mandated for recovery of material as laid down by the Central Pollution Control Board in this regard.
- (13) Where an accident occurs at the facility processing e-waste or during transportation of e-waste, the producer, refurbisher, transporter, dismantler, or recycler, as the case may be, shall report immediately to the UPPCB about the accident through telephone and e-mail.
- (14) Unit shall collect e-waste generated during the process of refurbishing and hand over the waste to registered recycler and upload information on the portal.
- (15) Unit shall ensure that the refurbished equipment shall be as per Compulsory Registration Scheme of the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology and Standards of Bureau of Indian Standards framed for this purpose.
- (16) Unit shall file annual and quarterly returns in the laid down form on the portal on or before the end of the month succeeding the quarter or year, as the case may be, to which the return relates.
